Client Objective

Talley Street Elementary has the goal to inspire students to grow and develop their ability to learn, think, and inquire through meaningful, motivating, and rewarding learning experiences supported by highly qualified adults in a safe, supportive, and inviting community.

The school includes two, two-story classroom wings and a courtyard between the west wing and the gymnasium/cafeteria on the south side. Other highlights include a 40,000 square feet playfield, roughly the size of a soccer field, a smaller playground, and areas set aside for future expansion.

City Schools of Decatur and Perkins+Will worked to complete a final design concept for the new elementary school. The design team worked hard to take community input from a focus group session, multiple steering committee meetings, and community-wide meetings. This input drove efforts resulting in a refined design concept that echoes the community's desires and needs.

NTI is proud to have a part in Decatur's first new school in over thirty years. The school covers approx. 90,000 SF on the 6.38-acre property. Talley Street Elementary took over a year to construct and the final result was amazing!
